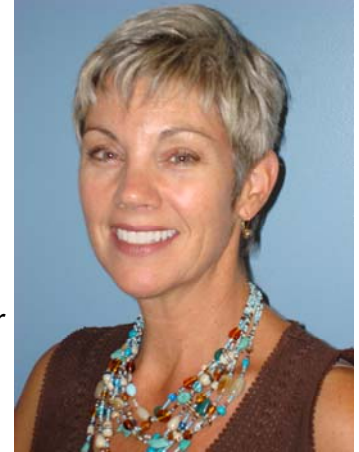

Part 1 will provide an understanding of the dynamics of sexual abuse, including what to do if you have concerns about a person's behavior or if you suspect that someone has been molested, and how to recognize signs that a person may have been abused. This is excellent training for any adult concerned about the safety of children and youth.

Part 2 offers concrete steps you can take to help prevent sexual abuse in church and school settings. This training is designed for clergy and lay staff who are responsible for planning, implementing or supervising congregational ministries, activities and programs.

Each participant will go home with the knowledge needed and tools to make sure the children and youth in your congregation are safe from sexual predators.
