- If a grant is awarded, the applicant agrees to submit a written report to the Pacifica Synod by October 15, 2022 telling how the monies were spent, matching funds raised and what results were achieved to be considered for awards in future years.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD:

1. The primary criteria may be found in Matthew 25 (refer to “Purpose”). Secondary criteria is that the project will help establish and/or maintain congregational outreach and unity.
2. Preference will be given to congregations in the Pacifica Synod of ELCA. Consideration may be given to other Christian organizations with proven responsible management.
