MISSION FUNDS COMMITTEE MEMBER

Members of the Mission Funds Committee are elected to three-year terms and eligible for re-election. A Mission Funds Committee member may be a lay person or rostered minister and does not receive a salary for serving on this committee.

Mission Funds Committee members shall:

- Be committed to the mission and core values of the Synod.
- Oversee and make recommendations to the Executive Committee of the Synod Council for the disbursement of certain funds, including without limitation the New, Transformation and Re-development Mission Fund (hereafter referred to as the “Mission Fund”).
- Oversee and make recommendations to the Executive Committee of the Synod Council regarding the disbursement of funds from such other funds as the Synod Council shall designate from time to time, including without limitation the following funds of the Pacifica Synod: First Call Theological Education; Latino Ministry Fund; Cathryn Wright Fund; Matthew 25 Fund; Mission Fund 2015; Portico Wellness Dollars; Robert L. Miller Scholarship; Murray and Rhoda Finck Global Engagement Mission (GEM) Fund; and Warner Trust Fund.
- Meet at least quarterly, or more frequently as deemed by it in the best interest of the Funds. Committee members may participate in a meeting through use of conference telephone, electronic video screen communication, or other electronic transmission.
- Be an active member of a Pacifica Synod congregation.
- Have a cooperative style of working.
- Fulfill the responsibilities per the Pacifica Mission Funds By-Laws.
