

## Resolutions Addendum:

### **Constitution Updates:**

The Constitution Review Committee, together with the Resolutions Committee, intended to bring for vote to this assembly changes to the Pacifica Synod's Constitution and Bylaws. Unfortunately, people reviewing the changes recently discovered an omission that would compromise the voice and vote of rostered ministers with disability status or on leave from call at future Pacifica Synod Assemblies. The draft changes to the constitution, as circulated in November 2022, cannot be amended on the floor. Therefore, rather than exclude the voice of any voting member, the committees have recommended that this assembly delay the vote until the 2024 Pacifica Synod Assembly so that the omission may be corrected.

### **Resolution received after the 90 day deadline:**

Resolution 23-05 was submitted after the 90 day deadline. According to the assembly rules, if the Secretary of the Synod receives any resolutions after the 90-day deadline, they will also be reviewed by the Resolutions Committee. These resolutions will be brought before the Synod Assembly, but will be placed on the agenda only with the consent of the Assembly by a 2/3rds majority vote. Any resolutions which are not considered by the Synod Assembly due to lack of time, are referred to the Synod Council for action.
